With an extensive academic and profesional training, H.E. Mrs Carmelo Nvono-Ncá were nominated in 2011, through a direct decisión made by the President of the Republic of Equatorial Guinea, Ambassador to the Kingdom of Belgium, the Kingdom of Netherlands, the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg and the Kingdom of Denmark. He is also the Permanent Representative of his country to the European Union, the OACPS, the IMO and the OPCW. The efficiency with which he led his diplomatic activities swiftly pushed him as an agent of Equatorial Guinea before the International Court of Justice on two occasions.
